On behalf of the Yorkshire Air Ambulance Charity we would like to thank you for your generous donation of £ 261.00. We do hope an enjoyable time was had by all who attended your Chartist Concert York Minster.

The Yorkshire Air Ambulance operates two Helicopters one based at Leeds Bradford Airport, one at RAF Topcliffe. These can be airborne in 2 minutes, flying at speeds of up to 140mph. Wherever the Air Ambulance lands within Yorkshire there is a hospital within 10 minutes' flying time. This means that injured patients can be taken quickly and smoothly to hospital for specialist care – it is this swift medical intervention that has a major impact on a patient's chance of survival and recovery. The Air Ambulance can also deliver a fast inter-hospital transfer of seriously ill or injured patients with a high level of patient comfort, especially to those with serious head, neck and spinal injuries.

It is the goodwill, sponsorship and charitable donations that keep this vital service flying and therefore, we are extremely grateful for all your support - without the generosity of people such as yourself we would be unable to continue this valuable work.
